The Challenge

R



ristina Hiatt teaches high school English in an early college program where students earn both a diploma and an associate's degree. She needed an adaptive, userfriendly program to provide differentiated reading materials for students at various levels and help them succeed on standardized assessments. The ideal tool would offer test prep and data tracking to bring students to a similar grade-appropriate level.

The Solution

Kristina has integrated ReadTheory into her curriculum consistently since discovering it through a Google search years ago. She employs ReadTheory twice weekly to boost students' fluency and comprehension. **Students manage their Google Data Sheets independently, tracking pretest scores, program averages, and completed passages to enhance accountability and motivation.** Kristina facilitates student discussions on ReadTheory activities, passage analysis, and error understanding, emphasizing critical reflection and correct answer analysis. She utilizes leveled worksheets from the site for targeted small group instruction, emphasizing key reading strategies.

The Impact

Kristina finds ReadTheory's questions are aligned to to North Carolina's End-of-Course (EOC) state exam in both format and cognitive demand, noting, **"If you can answer ReadTheory questions, you can answer your exam questions."** Over five years, ReadTheory has aided her early college students in improving skills and securing university acceptance.

Her students consistently achieved the highest county scores in English II EOC assessments over the past two years thanks to consistent practice on ReadTheory.
